Courses will run only if there is sufficient level of numbers to commence a course

Courses are **free** to all EU applicants with -

***\*less than upper second level standard of education i.e. QQI Level 4, 5 or leaving certificate (this should be stated on BTEI course application form and signed by student)***

***\*in receipt of Social Welfare Payment (please get BTEISW Form 2 stamped from DEASP office)***

***\* dependant on a Social Welfare recipient (please get BTEISW Form 2 stamped from DEASP office)***

***\*with a current medical card (please forward a copy of Medical Card to BTEI Office) signing for credits (please get BTEISW Form 2 stamped from DEASP office)***

***\*Up to Level 5 courses are free under Skills to Advance Scheme to EU Applicants if they are not working for companies with >250 employees or the public sector***

*Applicants who are not eligible for free tuition, the cost per module will be €150 which must be paid on course commencement.*

Payment can be made to BTEI Office, MSLETB, Quay Street, Sligo by Cheque, Postal Order or Bank Draft.

Priority of course places on BTEI Programmes are given to early school leavers with less than upper second level education (Less than 5 D's in Leaving Certificate), those in receipt of Job
